During Covid, the times of the school day were adapted to allow for an extended start and end to the day to stop groups of pupils staff and parents gathering etc.

Currently doors open in the morning at 8.50am, to allow for a ten minute transition time and class time to start at 9am. This will continue in September.

Currently, at the end of the school day, we begin the transition on to transport at 2.55pm. In September we will begin loading vehicles at 3pm; with process running to 3.10pm. If you collect your child from school yourself, you will then have a 10 minute widow to collect (ie, you have until 3.10 rather than needing to be at the school for 3pm!). This takes us back to pre Covid timings and may also help with the flow of traffic at both entrances.
