8.11.22 STEM Day (Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths)

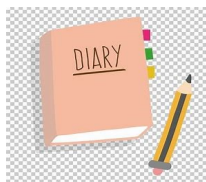
all classes will take part in a STEM activity.
